The provisional Ph.D. applicants are admitted on the condition that they submit a report of English Proficiency Test with a score meeting the program's admission requirements: TOEFL 580 or IELTS 6.5 by January 10, 2023. Failure to present the score report will result in the expiration of status as a Ph.D. student.

1. Documents for Enrollment

- 1.1 Two photocopies of official transcripts of Master's degree and Bachelor's degree
- 1.2 Two photocopies of Master's degree and Bachelor's degree diploma
- 1.3 Two photocopies of identification card/passport
- 1.4 A photocopy of house registration certificate
- 1.5 A medical certificate issued by a physician or a medically qualified healthcare provider which certifies that you are free of contagious diseases or other serious health conditions that can interfere with your study. This medical certificate can be requested at any private/public hospital or clinic and must be valid within one month only.
- 1.6 Three photographs (1" size, not wearing academic gown)
- 1.7 Evidence of name change(s), e.g., marriage certificate (if any)
- 1.8 Record of TOEFL or IELTS score

Applicants whose degrees were conferred by non-Thai higher educational institutions must also provide:

N.B. (i) All photocopies of documents must be signed by the applicant (certified copy).

(ii) Students cannot enroll in more than one program at NIDA. If they are current students in any program at NIDA, their enrollment in the new program shall be cancelled.

(iii) Former students whose status has been cancelled and students who owe NIDA any payments (e.g., uncollected fees, unpaid bills, library fines, etc.) will be allowed to enroll only after the outstanding payments have been made.

Note: Applicants must submit the documents mentioned in section 1.9 and 1.10 by January 10, 2022; otherwise, their application shall be considered incomplete and their student status will be void.

- October 29-31, 2021: Students pay the registration fee at Bangkok Bank, Kasikorn Bank,
Krungsri Bank, or Counter Service (online payment is also valid).
Failure to make the payment by the specified time will result in the
student being dropped from registration.
