They must enroll in a 3-credit course (PET 5000) in semester 1/2019 and submit a score report of the English proficiency test (TOEFL/550, IELTS/6.0 or higher) before the end of semester 1/2019. Provided your test score report is submitted and verified within the specified time period, the students will be able to enrol as regular students, otherwise their non-credit student status will be terminated.

- 1.1 Two photocopies of official transcripts of Master's degree and Bachelor's degree
- 1.2 Two photocopies of Master's degree and Bachelor's degree diploma
- 1.3 Two photocopies of identification card/passport
- 1.4 A photocopy of house registration certificate (for Thai applicants)
- 1.5 A medical certificate issued by a physician or a medically qualified healthcare provider which certifies that you are free of contagious diseases or other serious health conditions that can interfere with your study. This medical certificate can be requested at any private/public hospital or clinic and, to be valid, must be dated not before one month prior to date of submission.
- 1.6 Three photographs (1" size, not wearing academic gown)
- 1.7 Evidence of name change(s), e.g., marriage certificate (if any)
- 1.8 Record of TOEFL or IELTS score

Applicants whose degrees were conferred by non-Thai higher educational institutions must also provide:

- N.B. (i) All photocopies of the documents must be signed by the applicant (certified copy).
- (ii) Students cannot enroll in more than one program at NIDA. If they are current students in any program at NIDA, their enrollment in the new program shall be cancelled.

(iii) Former students whose status has been cancelled and students who owe NIDA any payments (e.g., uncollected fees, unpaid bills, library fines, etc.) will be allowed to enroll only after the outstanding payments have been made.

Note: Applicants must submit the documents mentioned in section 1.9 and 1.10 by August 7, 2019; otherwise, their application shall be considered incomplete and their student status will be void.

The National Institute of Development Administration reserves the right to verify any enrollment documents at any time. Should any of the documents be proven unauthorized or do not meet the requirements of the Institute in any way, the student will be deemed unqualified. The Institute also reserves the right to take legal action against the student's use of unlawful documents.

2. Enrollment and Tuition Payment

Shortlisted applicants must submit all required documents to the Educational Service Division (Prince Naradhip Building, 4th Floor), between July 23 - 26, 2019, from 9:00 a.m. to 12.00 a.m. and from 1.00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. After the document submission, username and password codes will be issued for online enrollment (<https://reg.nida.ac.th>). Failure to collect the enrollment documents by December 26, 2018 will result in the loss of student status.

Applicants can pay their tuition fees and charges by presenting the given enrollment form at the following banks from July 23 - 30, 2019. Failure to make the payment by July 30, 2019 will result in the loss of student status.
